## CROCHET PATTERN



Size
To fit tea pot with a max circumference of 53 cm (21 inches ) not including handle and spout.

## MATERIALS

Oddments of DK (light worsted) yarns or
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ball Adriafil Knitcol (125 metres/137 yards per 50 g ball)
$1 \times 25 \mathrm{~g}$ ball Patons Fab DK any bright shade to match ( 68 metres/ 75 yards per 25 g ball)
$1 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hook (USG/6)

## TO SUBSTITUTE:

Use correct length of yarn with a knit tension of 22 sts and $28 / 30$ rows to 10 cm square worked over stocking stitch on no 4 mm needles (UK/Canada/Australia no.8/US6).
Yarn quantities are approximate.

## TENSION/GAUGE

Tension is not critical.

## ABBREVIATIONS (US))

Ch - chain
Sc - single crochet
Dc - double crochet
Sp - space
Rep - repeat
Beg - beginning

## NOTE

If using multiple oddments of yarn, either join at the beginning of each round / row, OR join as you go.

## TO MAKE

Using no 4 mm crochet hook make a magic circle and into it work as follows;
1st Round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into ring, * 2 ch, 3 dc into ring, rep from * two more times. Pull up the magic circle to tighten, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round.

2nd round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into sc sp, * 1 ch , ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp, rep from * two more times, 1 ch, 3 dc back into 1 st sp, 1 ch, 1 dc into $3 r d$ of 3 ch at beg of round.

3rd round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into sc sp, * $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $1 \mathrm{ch} \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch},(3 \mathrm{dc}$, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp , rep from * two more times, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp, 1 ch, 3 dc back into 1 st sp, 1 ch, 1 sc into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round.

4th round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into dc sp, * ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp ) x $2,1 \mathrm{ch}$, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp , rep from * two more times, ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp) x $2,1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ back into $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round.

5th round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into sc sp, * ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ dc in next 1 ch sp ) $\times 3,1 \mathrm{ch}$, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp , rep from * two more times, ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp) x 3, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ back into $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round.

6th round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into sc sp, * ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ dc in next 1 ch sp ) x $4,1 \mathrm{ch}$, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp , rep from * two more times, ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp ) $\times 4,1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ dc back into $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round.

7th round: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc), 2 dc into sc sp, * (1 ch, 3 dc in next 1 ch sp ) x 5, 1 ch, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp, rep from * two more times, ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp) $\times 5,1$ ch, 3 dc back into 1 st sp, 1 ch, 1 sc into 3 rd of 3 ch at beg of round

Now begin to work in rows as follows;
8th row: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), 2 dc into sc sp, * ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ dc in next 1 ch sp ) x 6, 1 ch , ( 3 dc , $2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp , rep from * once more , ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp) x 6, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ into corner. Turn work.

9th row: 3 ch (counts as 1 dc ), *( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp ) $\times 7,1 \mathrm{ch},(3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all worked into next 2 ch sp, rep from * once more, ( $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 1 ch sp ) x 6, 1 ch, 1 dc into last dc of row.
Fasten off.
Work another piece the same.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew together at side seams sewing 1 st 2.5 cm ( 1 inch ) at lower edge and $6 \mathrm{~cm}(2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) at top edge, leaving the gap in the middle for spout/handle.
Run a gathering thread around top opening and pull in. Sew up so that there is no hole at top.
Make a pom pom using a pom pom maker or cardboard rings, and attach to the top.
