# Ruth Maddock <br> <br> Knit Crochet Design 

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## Size

The rose measures approx $7 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ across - not including the leaf.

## Materials

25 meters from a 50 g ball of DK (Light Worsted) knitting wool in Red
2.5 meters of green for the leaf

4 mm crochet hook ( UK/Aus/Canada 8/ US 6)
Brooch back to make it into a brooch.
Wool sewing needle.

## The UK/Australia/Canada Version

## Abbreviations

Ch—chain
Tr-treble
Sp-space
Ss—slip stitch

## The Rose

With 4 mm hook and red yarn make a length of 53 ch .
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) worked into $6^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook, (the first 5 ch count as 1 tr , 2ch), * 2ch, miss next two foundation chain, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) worked into next ch, repeat from * to end. ( 34 chain spaces)
2nd row: 3 ch , (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{tr}$ ), 4 tr into $1^{\text {st }} 2 \mathrm{ch} \mathrm{sp}$, ss in next 2 ch sp , ( 5 tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 2, (6tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch $\mathrm{sp}) \times 4$, (8tr in next 2 ch sp , ss into next 2 ch sp ) $\times 4$, (12tr in next 2 ch $\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ss}$ into next 2 ch sp$) \times 6$.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 50 cm ) for sewing.

## To Make Up

Starting at the beginning of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ row, roll the work so that it forms a rose shape. Arrange as required then sew into place on the base. Sew a brooch back onto the back of the rose. Sew in all ends.

## The Leaf

With 4 mm hook and green yarn make a length of 9 ch .
$\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ side of leaf: 1 htr into $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook ( $1^{\text {st }} 2$ ch counts as $1^{\text {st }}$ htr), 1 tr in each of next 2 ch, 1 dtr in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 htr in next ch, work 3 dc into last ch, and turn work.
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ side of leaf: working along other side of the same length of ch work as follows; 1 htr in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dtr in next ch, 1 tr in each of next 2 ch, 1 htr in each of last 2 ch.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 30 cm ) for sewing.

## To Attach

Using the long end sew the leaf onto the back of the rose so that it just peeps out from behind the rose. Sew in all ends.

## The US Version

## Abbreviations

Ch—chain
Ss—slip stitch
Sc-single crochet
Dc-double crochet

## The Rose

With 4 mm hook and red yarn make a length of 53 ch .
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) worked into $6^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook, (the first 5 ch count as 1 dc , 2ch), * 2ch, miss next two foundation chain, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) worked into next ch, repeat from * to end. ( 34 chain spaces)
2nd row: 3 ch , (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ), 4 dc into $1^{\text {st }} 2 \mathrm{ch} \mathrm{sp}$, ss in next 2 ch sp , ( 5 dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 2, (6dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch $s p) \times 4$, ( 8 dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp$) \times 4$, (12dcin next 2 ch sp , ss into next 2 ch sp$) \times 6$.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 50 cm ) for sewing.

## To Make Up

Starting at the beginning of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ row, roll the work so that it forms a rose shape. Arrange as required then sew into place on the base. Sew a brooch back onto the back of the rose. Sew in all ends.

## The Leaf

With 4 mm hook and green yarn make a length of 9 ch .
$\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ side of leaf: 1 hdc into $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook ( $1^{\text {st }} 2$ ch counts as $1^{\text {st }}$ hdc), 1 dc in each of next 2 ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch, work 3 sc into last ch, and turn work.
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ side of leaf: working along other side of the same length of ch work as follows; 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ hdc in each of last 2 ch.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 30 cm ) for sewing.

## To Attach

Using the long end sew the leaf onto the back of the rose so that it just peeps out from behind the rose. Sew in all ends.
